R A Lister and Company was founded in 1867, in Dursley, Gloucestershire, England. This example is thought to date from the 1940s . The company, after many changes, continues today (2022).

Clearly designed for farms without electricity, it has four shearing connections. Lister made the shears, too! Note, on the side are discs for sharpening the shears.

There are 12 other Lister engines in this museum dating from 1911 to 1959. Other Lister products include pumps, generators, churns and cream separators. Everything a farm might need in other words.
