



Re: The Sandstone Heritage Trust – A unique Eastern Free State destination.

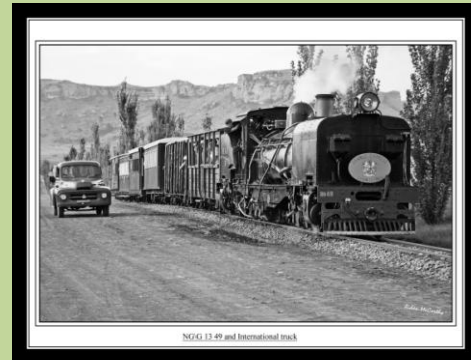
